Product Updates in Cartridge Oil Filters

The following oil filter part numbers will be changing in appearance due to some product design updates:

1370, 7213, 7214, 7215, 7311,
7526, and 7674

All filters are being updated with construction updates including higher strength end caps, center tubes; along with a switch to higher strength nitrile rubber seals.

The 1370, 7213, 7214, 7215, and 7311 use a design that incorporates skirted endcaps and a free floating bypass valve that uses the O.E. spring load in the housing standpipe.

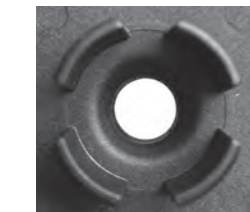
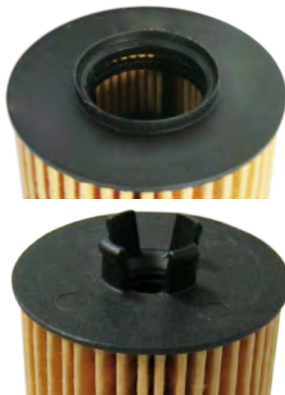

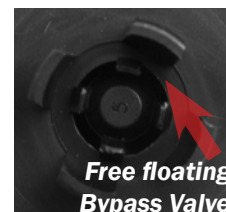

The 7526 and 7674 feature updates including the flat end caps, updated center tubes, and integral seals.

The most notable change is the uses of the O.E. spring load housing standpipe to close and load a newly designed valve plug that snaps into the top end cap.
